The CFOA 2009 exam will be issued the beginning of June 2009 and will feature two sections (A) general rules knowledge and(B) Rule applications.

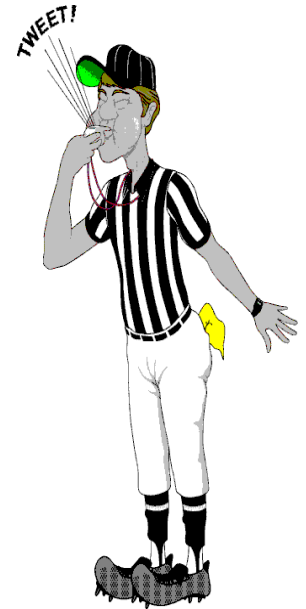

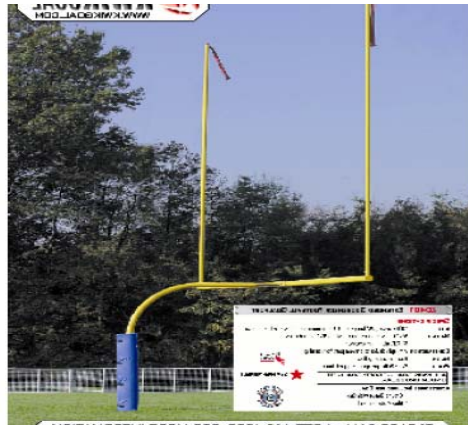

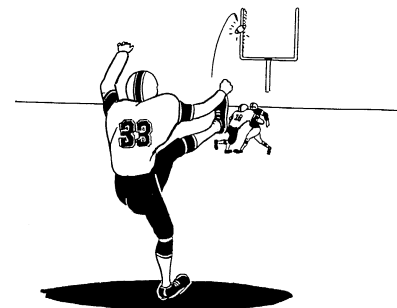

KICKOFF INTO THE B ENDZONE

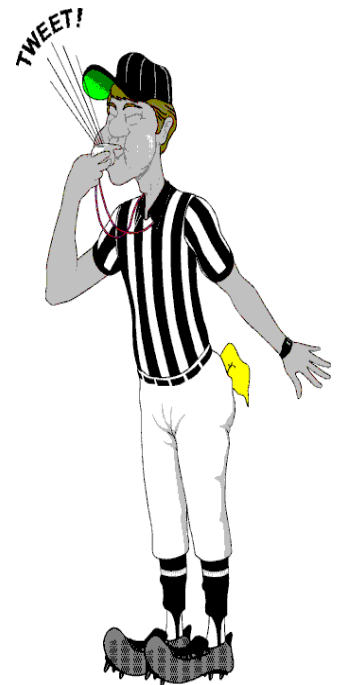
Provide the ruling

1. On a kick off, the ball travels through the end zone in flight.
2. The ball hits the goal post in flight on a A) kick off B) field goal
3. On a kick off the ball hits B23 on the B5 yard line and rolls through the end zone.
4. On a kick off B23 receives the ball in the B end zone, fumbles the ball and A72 touches the ball before it goes out of bounds in the end zone.
5. B17 receives a kick off in the B end zone and fumbles the ball across the goal line and out of bounds at the B3 yard line.
6. B15 receives a kick off in the B end zone, fumbles and B52 kicks the loose ball across the goal line and out of bounds at the B7



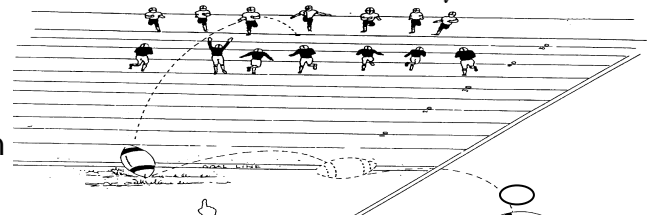

PUNT INTO THE TEAM B ENDZONE

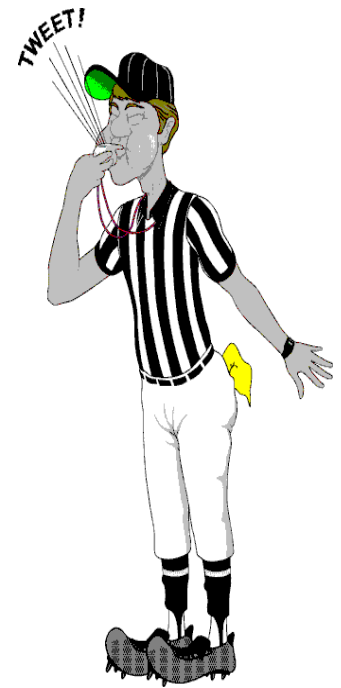
Provide the ruling



1. On a punt, the ball travels through the end zone in flight. Ruling?
2. A punt the ball lands in the end zone and goes out of bounds over the sideline in goal.
3. On a punt the ball hits the ground at the B2 yard line, rolls and hits the goal post and is recovered by B30 in the end zone.
4. On a punt the ball is legally recovered in the B end zone by A1.
5. B23 receives a Team A punt in the B end zone, fumbles the ball and kicks the ball out of bounds over the dead ball line.
6. B22 receives the ball in the B end zone, advances it to the B3, retreats into the B end zone and is tackled.
7. B27 makes an offside pass to B15 in the B end zone after receiving a Team A punt. The ball is dead (a) in the end zone (b) in at the B 5 yard line

Provide the ruling

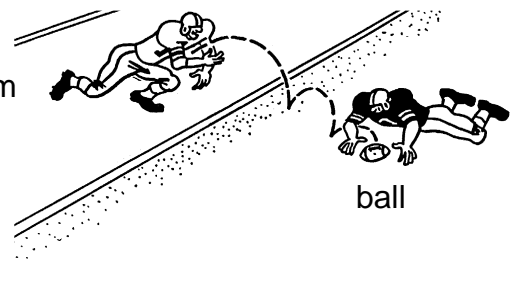
1. Team A fumble the ball into the B end zone, where Team B player recovers .

3. A1 fumbles the ball into the B end zone. B2 picks up the ball and throws it

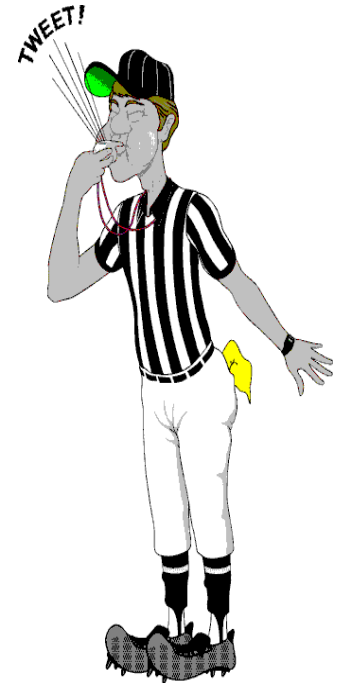
- a) Out of bounds at the B3 yard line

4. Team A fumbles the ball and Team B player knocks the ball into the B end zone. B recovers the ball in the end zone.



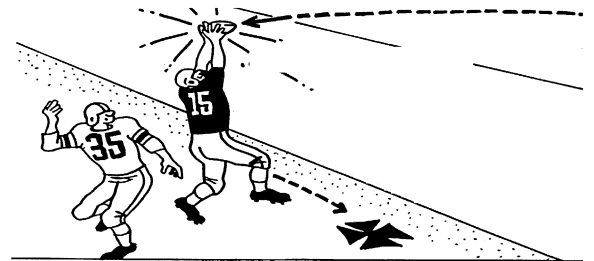

PASS INTERCEPTED IN THE ENDZONE

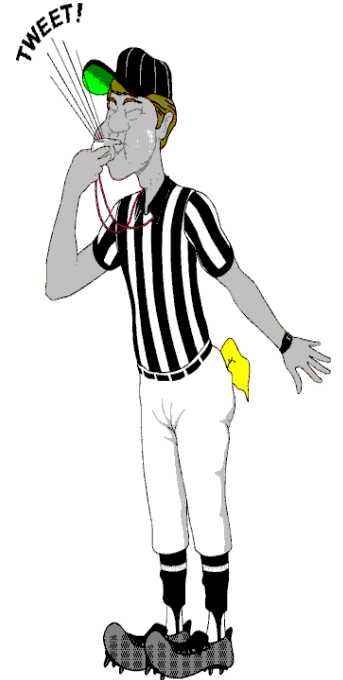
Provide the ruling

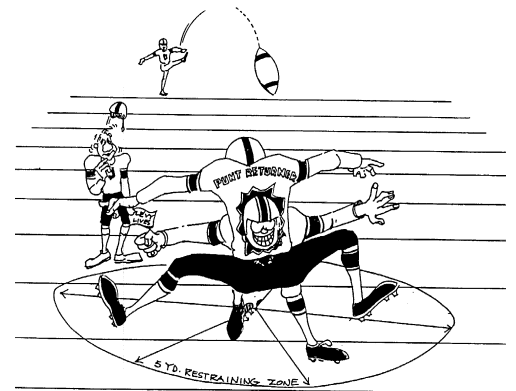

INFRACTIONS WITH THE BALL IN THE B ENDZONE

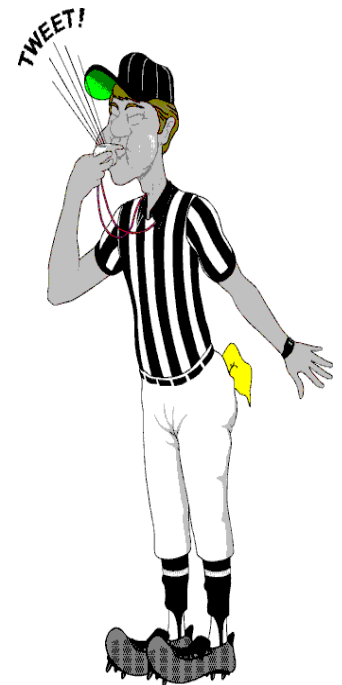
Provide the ruling

2. Team A is called for No Yards in the B end zone . Ruling?
3. Following a punt by Team A, the ball is loose in the Team B end zone. Team A commits illegal interference, preventing B from gaining possession? Ruling?
4. On a missed field goal from the B40, A 43 runs into the B end zone and
 - a) dives on the ball to recover it
 - b) knocks down the Team B player attempting to field the ball and recovers the ball

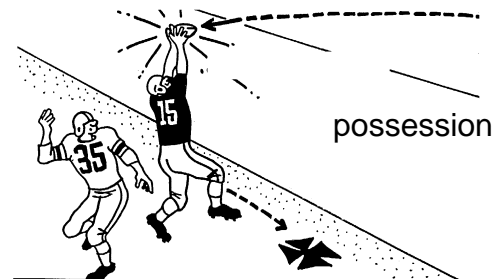

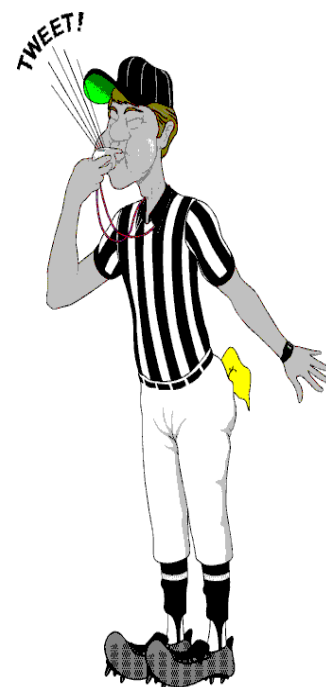

Provide the ruling

1 A has 1D at the A3 yard line. A1 pitches out to A2 who is tackled in the A end zone

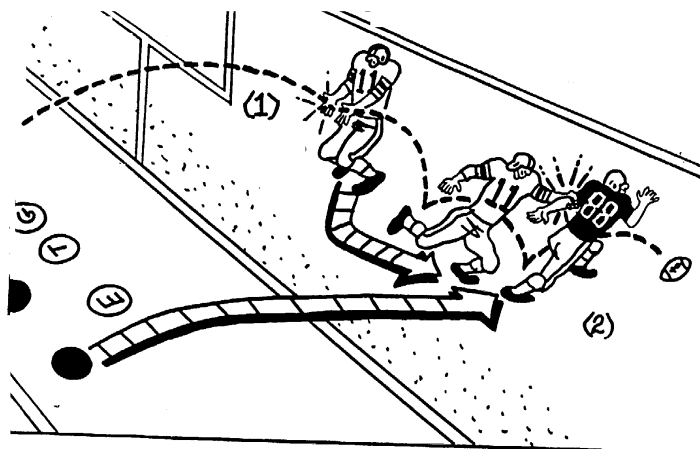
2.A2 drops back to pass and is tackled with the ball resting on the A goal line.

3. A3 fumbles the ball from the A end zone directly out of bounds at the A5 on:

- a) A's 2D and 8 from the A3 yard line
- b) A's 3D and 8 from the A3 yard line

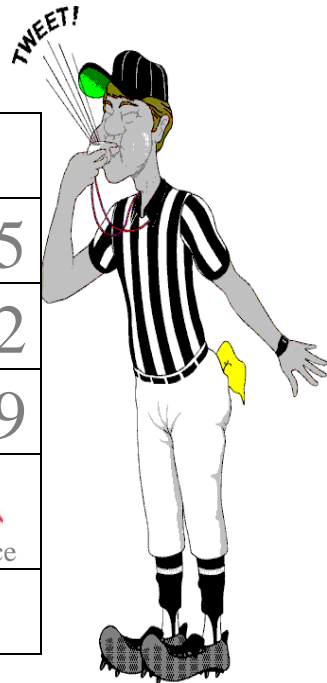
4. On a scrimmage play, A2 fumbles the ball in his end zone and it goes out of bounds in the A end zone after :

5. A25 drops back into the A end zone to pass. The pass hits the goal post and:

6. Team A has 2D and 5 at the 3 yard line. B1 is called for contacting the passer in the end zone.

7. Team A has 2D and 5 at the A8 yard line. While the passer A1 is in the A end zone,

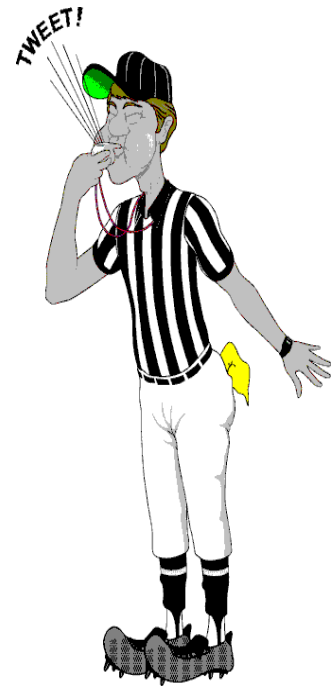
A2: a) Holds b). commits U.R. in the end zone. The ball goes dead in A's possession at the A3 yard line.

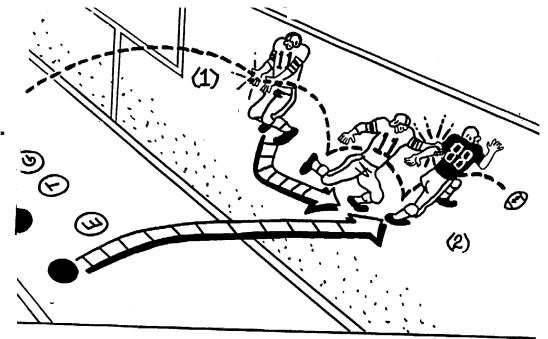
Provide the ruling

9. Team A has 1D and 10 at the A5 yard line. A1 fumbles the ball in his end zone. A2 holds B2, preventing B2 from recovering the ball in the end zone. A retains possession.

10. Team A has 3D and 10 at the A3 yard line. A1 is back in the A end zone to punt. A1 fumbles the snap and, while the ball is loose, B1 holds A1 to allow B2 to recover the ball.

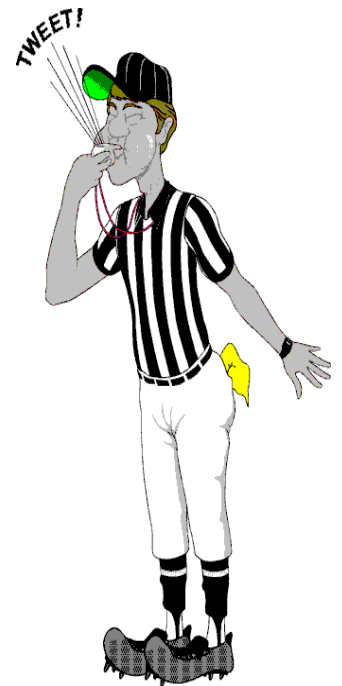
11. Team A has 2D and 5 at the 3 yard line. B1 is called for roughing the passer

12. Team A has 3D and 10 at the A3 yard line. A1 is back in the A end zone to punt. A1 fumbles the snap and, while the ball is loose, B1 holds A1 to allow B2 to recover the ball.

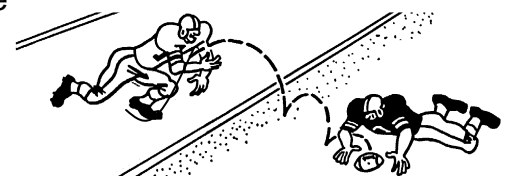

Dribbled Ball and the End Zone

Provide the ruling

- Team A 2nd D and 6 on the Team 5 yard line. Team A QB fumbles the ball and then kicks the loose ball into the end zone where it goes out of bounds
 - Directly
 - After being touched by B67 in the end zone.
- Team A attempt a field goal from the B25. The holder fumbles the snap. The kicker kicks the loose ball
 - through the up rights and the Back officials signal field goal and whistle the play dead
 - The kicked ball lands in the end zone where Team B player gains possession of the ball and
 - Is tackled in the end zone
 - Is able to run the ball out to the team B 2 yard line.
- Team A 35 fumbles the ball at the Team B 5 yard line and dribbles the ball into the Team B end zone where it is recovered by
 - an offside Team A player
 - a Team B player
